

EDUCATION LEADERS PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT - MEDIATION SKILLS FOR CONFLICT RESOLUTION

Principals and those in other education leadership roles often confront complex and challenging inter-personal situations in their role in the school. Areas of dispute can arise with and between staff, with students, parents and members of the broader school community. This one-day professional seminar focuses on building a new set of conflict resolution skills for education leaders following the principles of alternative dispute resolution (or mediation). These skills will help you to prevent a dispute escalating into a major conflict. This will also prove to be a great networking opportunity for leaders in schools. The seminar is free for IEU members.

The seminar will be run by Lisa Heap, who is an Adjunct Professor at the Australian Catholic University. She is a trained mediator and has extensive experience as an educator. Professor Heap is a member of Vic Health's Leading Thinkers initiative and a member of the Ministerial Council on Women's Equality. She is a labour lawyer and human rights practitioner.
