# When times get tough

Ann faced a drawn out and 'dirty' WorkCover claim after sustaining serious injuries. She says the IEU 'diligently worked to get me back to my employment'.

'I have been a union member all my life and have never had to use it. I didn't deserve what happened to me or still to this day know why, but my industrial officer and the union were with me every step of the way, guiding, communicating, and taking everything head on.'

Ann won her job back, and her claim. She wanted her story told so other people don't fall victim to a similar scenario. 'Please don't be the person to think it will never happen to you, because life can change in an instant and depending on who you are dealing with, and their agendas things can change dramatically. You need your union.'

# **Getting paid properly**

Part-timer Matt sent his timetable to his Organiser for review, she confirmed that he was being underpaid and spoke to his leadership. His fraction was fixed from 0.6FTE to 0.65FTE and he received backpay for the period he was wrongly categorised.

# Union campaigning offers hope

Anti-gender-violence activist Richard is motivated by 'seeing the positive results of campaigning and working as a group to achieve an outcome. This could be at a local, sector, or societal level. In essence, it's being part of a larger voice that can contribute to change for a better and fairer society. The sense of camaraderie amongst union members when we come together is fantastic, be it at training, council, or a bigger events'.

'Seeing young teachers, passionate about education and social justice, joining our ranks to push for better outcomes for our students and profession is wonderful. They are the continued lifeblood of our profession and the union movement, something that is very heartening.'
